**YOUR ORGANIZATION IS IN JEOPARDY OF LOSING ITS TAX-EXEMPT STATUS!!**

Most tax-exempt organizations must file a yearly return with the Internal Revenue Service. If an organization does not file as required for three consecutive years, they lose their tax-exempt status. A recent list published by the Internal Revenue Service has your Non-Profit Organization listed for not filing the required tax returns. By not filing these forms your tax-exempt status is in jeopardy. There is still time to retain your tax exempt status but you must act before October 15, 2010.

If you lose your tax exempt status your donor contributions are no longer tax deductible. Your organization may be required to file additional tax forms with the Internal Revenue Service and pay income tax on your donations. Once you lose your tax-exempt status, reinstatement may cost you thousands of dollars in time and money.
